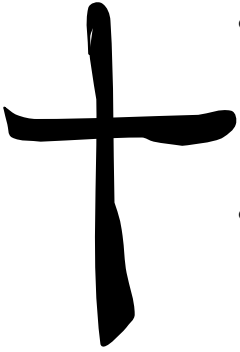
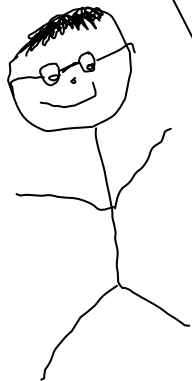


St. John Vianney Preschool is growing!

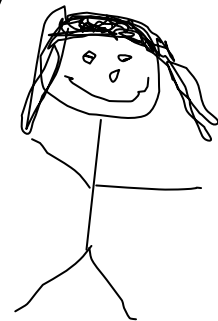


- For the 2012/2013 school year, we have expanded our program. Applications for the 2012/2013 will start being taken in January.

CURRICULUM

Annette Schwientek, director and lead teacher has over 18 years experience, and a degree in Early Childhood Development. Her classroom management practices, patience, and knowledge of curriculum will be combined with the philosophies of our Faith Formation Program. Annette and all of the teachers, work closely with Laura Stanger, Children and Family Life Director at St. John Vianney.

By creating a child focused preschool, we are able to nurture individual needs with our 8-2 student teacher ratio, foster individuality and creativity with open-ended projects all while providing a theme based, faith filled developmentally appropriate curriculum which includes all aspects of leaning; academic, social and spiritual.

The curriculum will include art, science, music, small and large motor skill development and manipulative materials to enhance pre-reading and pre-math skills. We'll read bundles of stories to further language development; have outside playtime and include fun, love and laughter.
